


Somalia

1 - 31 January 2020

In January, 35,000 new internal displacements were monitored by the UNHCR-led Protection and Returns Monitoring Network (PRMN). Drivers include conflict and insecurity (28,000), drought-related (6,000), and other reasons (1,000).


In Bay region, more than 22,000 people were reported fleeing Al Shabaab incursions on villages near Berdale. Violence, destruction of property, demands for 'taxation' and child recruits were reported. New displacements also continue from Lower Shabelle to Banadir (2,000 in the month).

refugees & asylum-seekers

As of the reporting month, there were 35,685 refugees and asylum-seekers registered in Somalia, mainly from Ethiopia (17,508 asylum seekers and 4,268 refugees) and Yemen (55 asylum seekers and 13,238 refugees). 626 persons were from other countries including Syria (266), Tanzania (121), Eritrea (108) among others.


refugee returnees (2014 - 2020)

Since December 2014, 91,539 Somali refugees have voluntarily returned to Somalia with UNHCR assistance from different countries of asylum including Kenya, Yemen, Djibouti, Libya, Sudan and Eritrea. In addition, some 38,000 Somalis were monitored as arriving from Yemen since March 2015.




Somali returnees from Kenya by month

Number of returnees (with assistance from UNHCR) since 2014






