Due to the situation in Venezuela, the number of people arriving in Colombia from the neighbouring country continues to increase. By the end of 2019, **1.7 million** Venezuelans were living in Colombia and, according to the population projections in the Response Plan (RMRP), by 2020 there will be **2.4 million** refugees and migrants in the country.

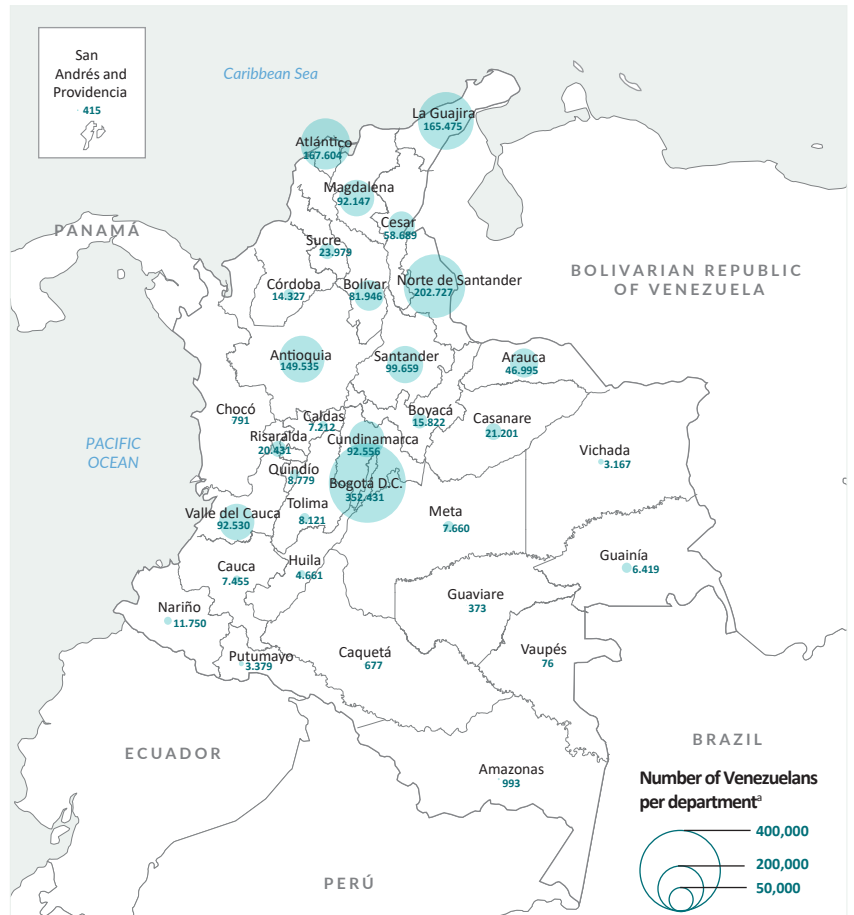
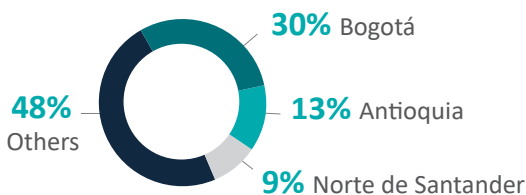

**54,331** renewed Phase II permits (from December 24, 2019).

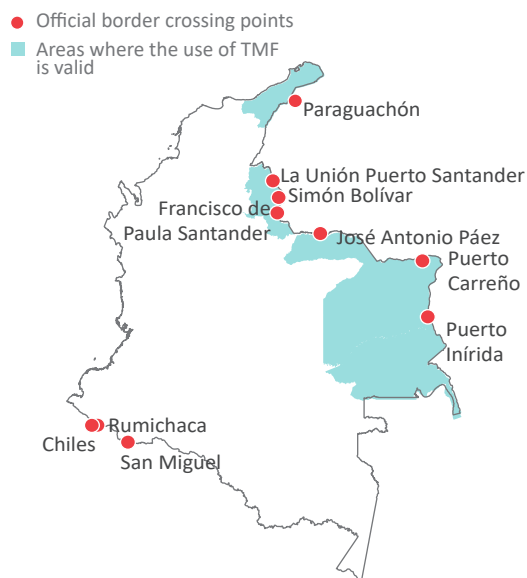
### Departments that concentrate Venezuelan population with PEP:



### In circular movement<sup>b</sup>

**4.94 million** Venezuelans with border mobility cards (TMF, by its acronym in Spanish)

**108,141** cards that have been revoked for misuse since February 8, 2017.



### In transit<sup>b</sup>

**40,948** temporary transit permits issued (PIP-PTT, by its acronym in Spanish).

**56,835** exits from the country to third countries.

### Exits through the Rumichaca border crossing 2019/20<sup>b</sup>

**462,828** exits to Ecuador in 2019.

**8,888** exits in 2020.
