Due to the situation in Venezuela, the number of people arriving in Colombia from the neighbouring country continues to increase. By the end of 2019, **1.7 million** Venezuelans were living in Colombia and, according to the population projections in the Response Plan (RMRP), by 2020 there will be **2.4 million** refugees and migrants in the country.

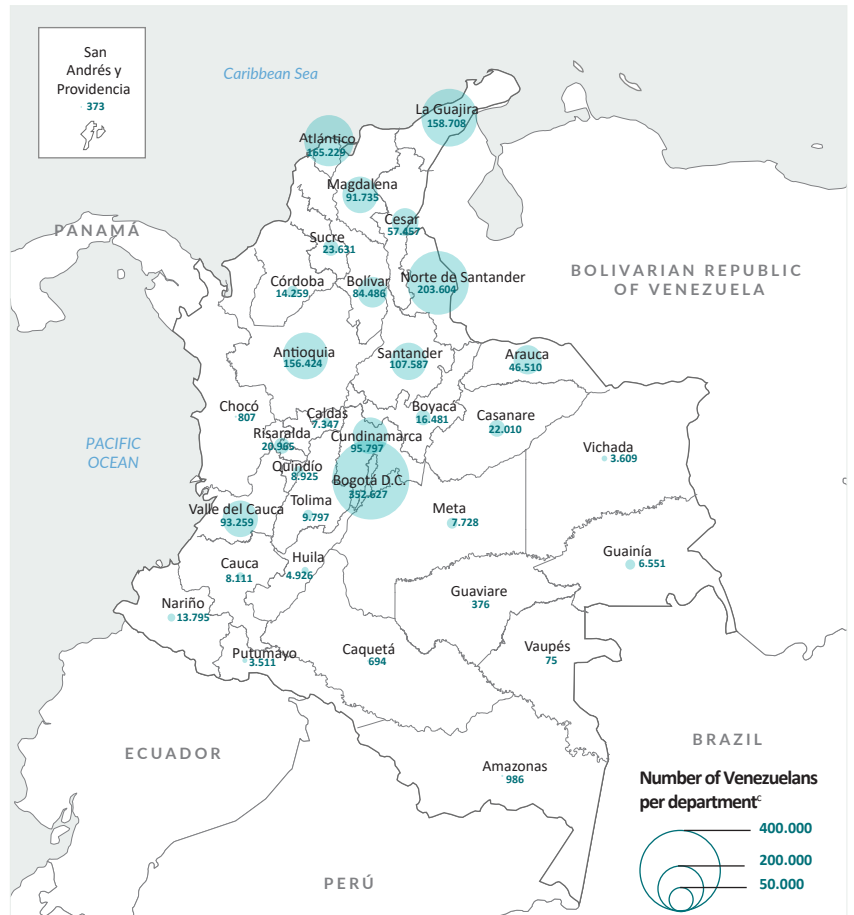
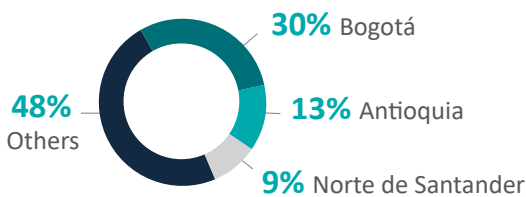
The total number shows a reduction of 2.1%, compared to the official figure of 1,825,687 as of February 2020.

61,201 renewed Phase II permits (from December 24, 2019).

4.98 million Venezuelans with border mobility cards (TMF, by its acronym in Spanish)

108,813 cards that have been revoked for misuse since February 8, 2017.
