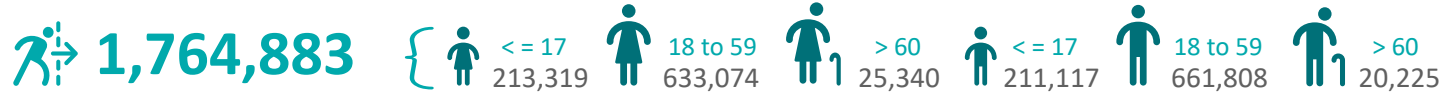
VENEZUELAN REFUGEES AND MIGRANTS

July 2020



By the end of February 2020, more than **1.8 million** Venezuelans were living in Colombia. Since the end of March, about **3%** of the population has returned to their homes in Venezuela, mostly due to the measures of Mandatory Preventive Isolation decreed by the National Government to deal with the **COVID-19** pandemic.

The total number shows a reduction of 3.3%, compared to the last official figure of 1,825,687 as of February 2020.

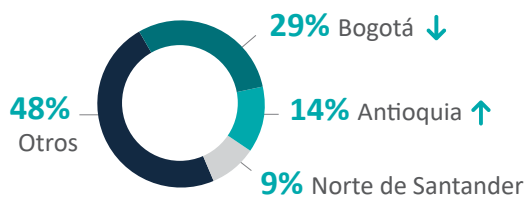
With the intention to stay^b

45,691 renewed Phase II permits since December 24, 2019

2,101 PEPFF permits (to promote the formalization of labor) since February 2020.

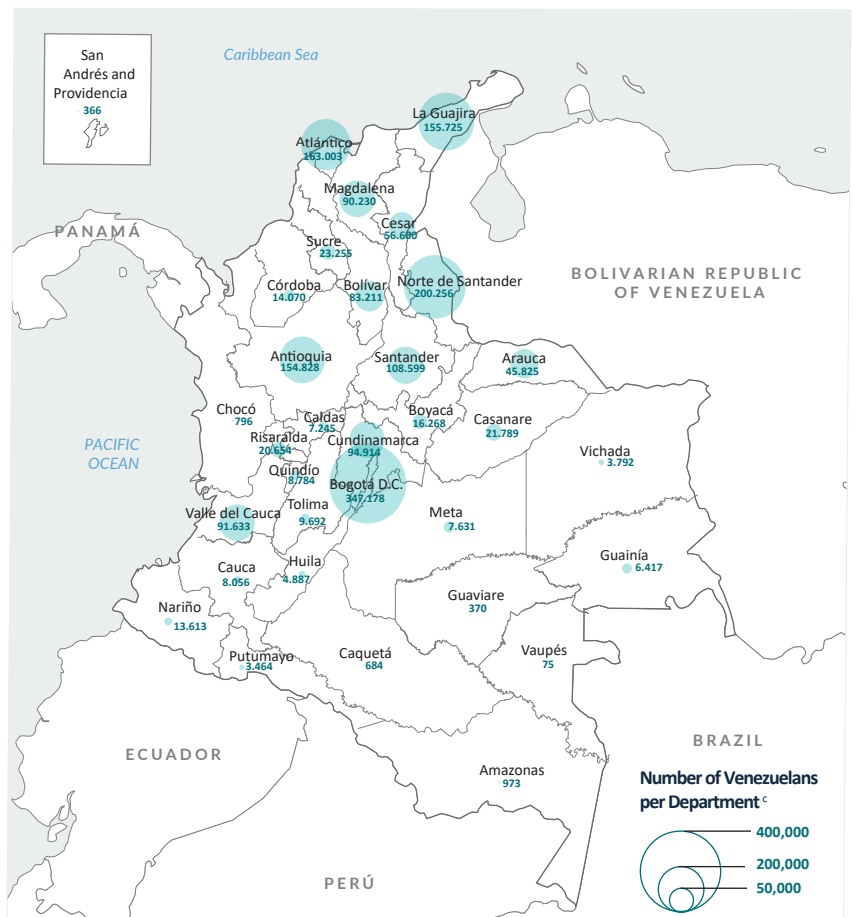
Departments that concentrate Venezuelan population with PEP:

52,797 temporary transit permits issued (PIP-PTT, by its acronym in Spanish).*

78,442 exits from Colombia to third countries.

91,905 exits into Venezuela through official crossing points.

462,828 exits to Ecuador in 2019.

11,943 exits in 2020.
