




# **Islamic Republic of Iran**

This map illustrates the distribution of refugee settlements and Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) across the Middle East, specifically in Turkey, Iraq, Iran, Afghanistan, and Pakistan. The legend provides the following key:

- UNHCR Presence**: Indicated by green circles.
- Refugee settlement in Iran**: Indicated by red triangles.
- Refugee settlement**: Indicated by red houses.
- IDP settlement**: Indicated by green houses.
- Returnee Centre**: Indicated by blue houses.
- International boundary**: Indicated by a green dashed line.
