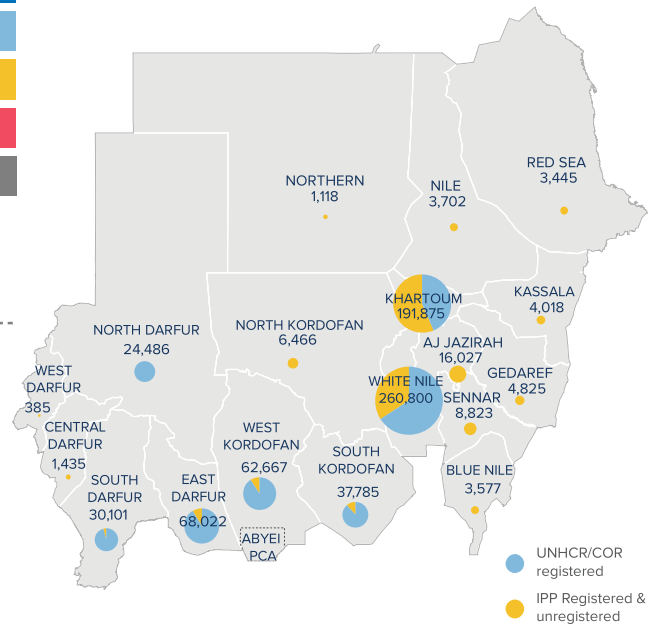

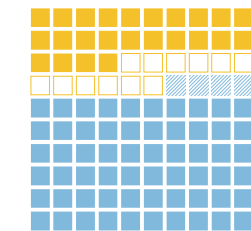

POPULATION BY STATE



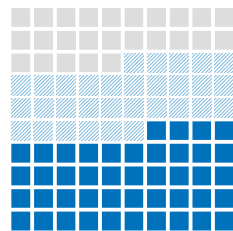

REGISTRATION STATUS



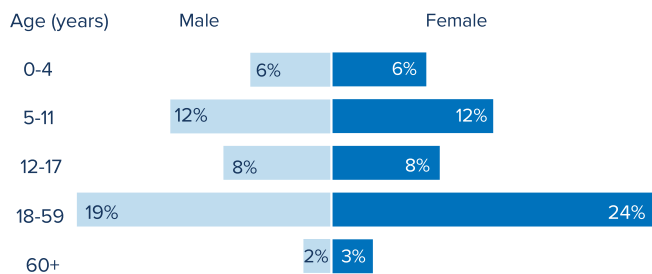

POPULATION DISTRIBUTION

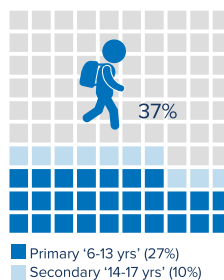


■ Camp population registered with UNHCR/COR (35%)

■ Out-of-camp - IPP registered & unregistered (36%)

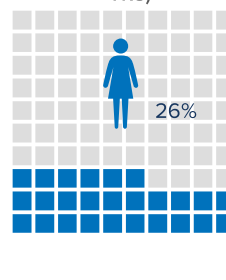
AGE-GENDER BREAKDOWN³



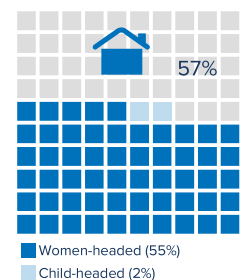
SCHOOL-AGE CHILDREN (6-17 YRS)³



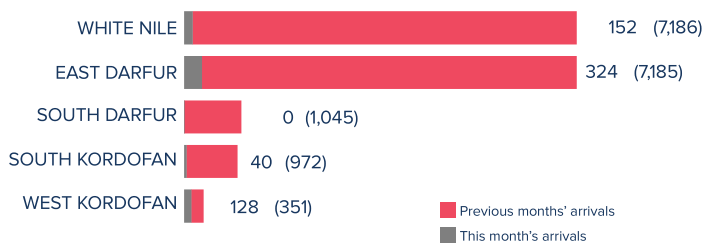
REPRODUCTIVE-AGE WOMEN/GIRLS (13-49 YRS)³



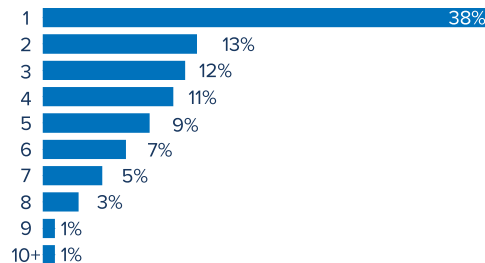
HOUSEHOLD DISTRIBUTION³



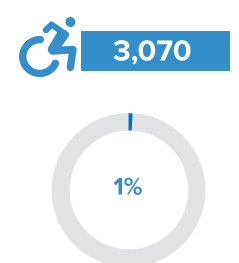
ARRIVALS BY STATE
