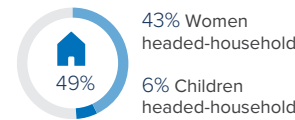
Age-gender Breakdown²



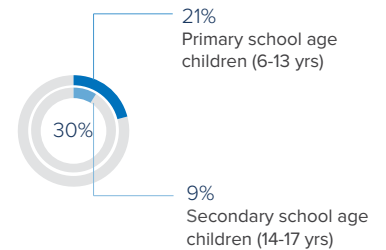

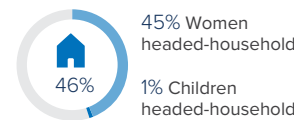
Age-gender Breakdown²



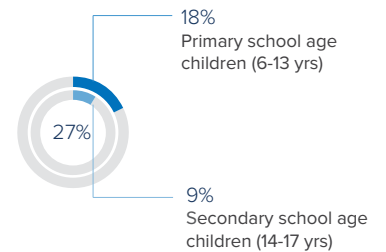
