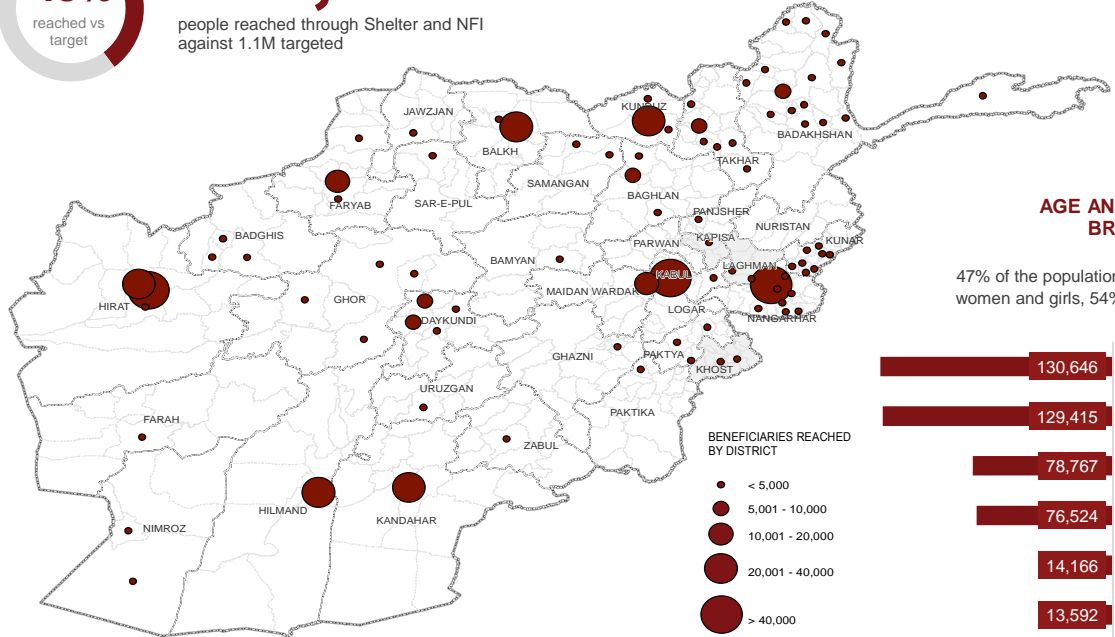




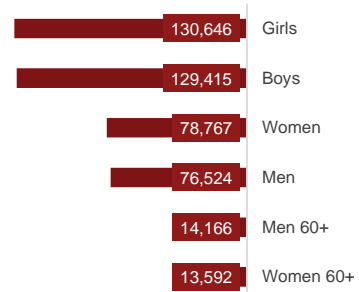

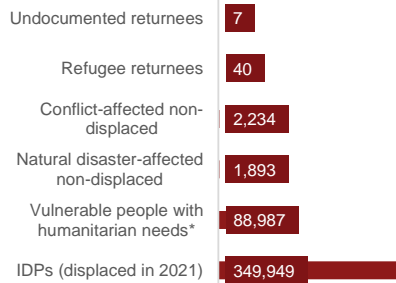


### AGE AND GENDER BREAKDOWN

47% of the population reached are women and girls, 54% are children

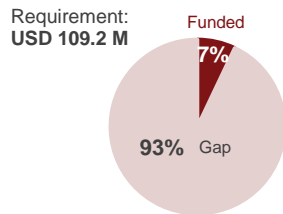


### BENEFICIARY TYPE
