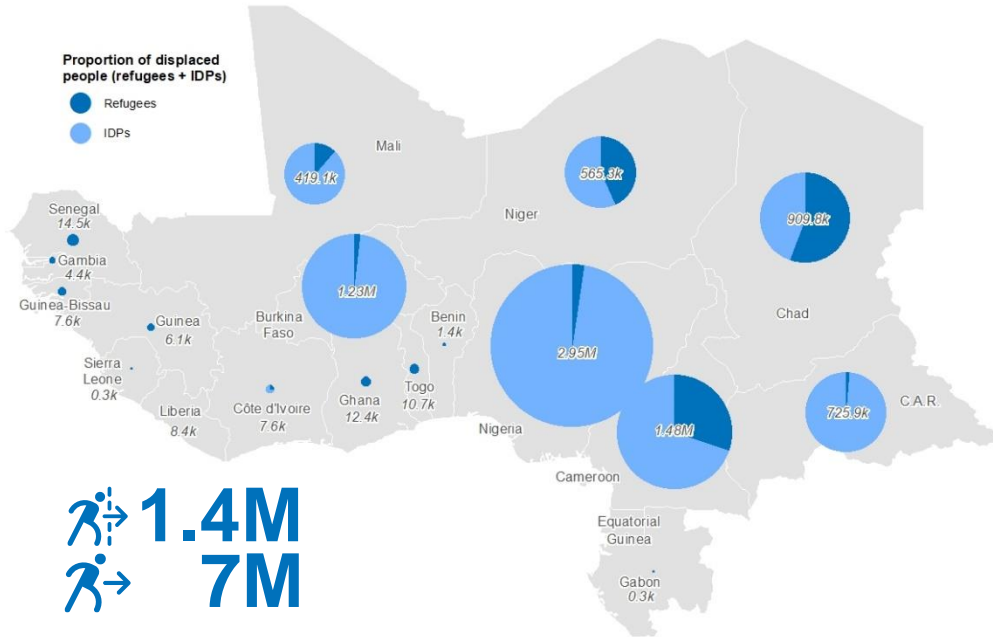


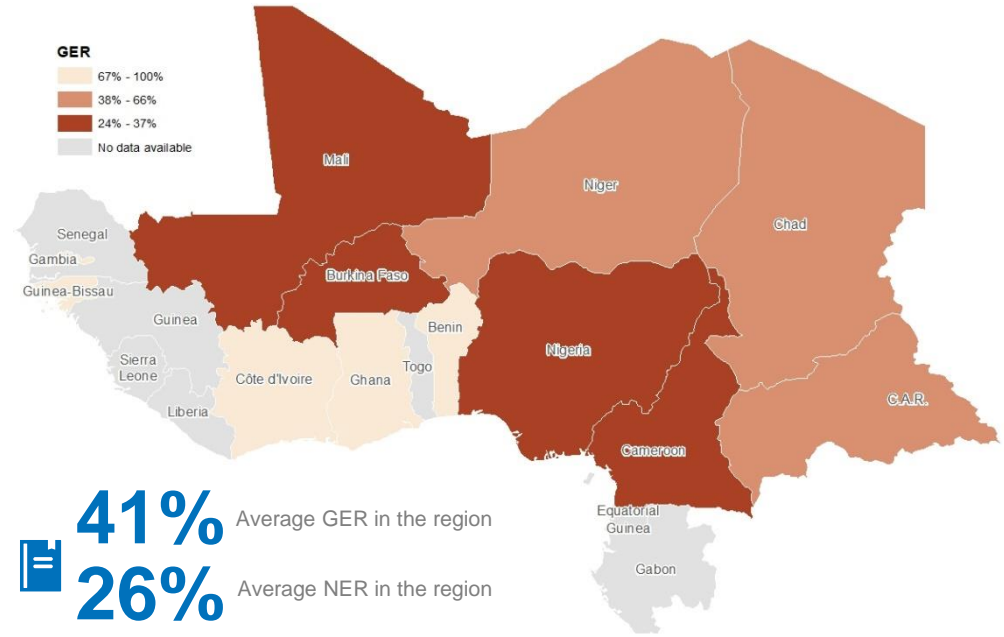

Total number of refugees and IDPs



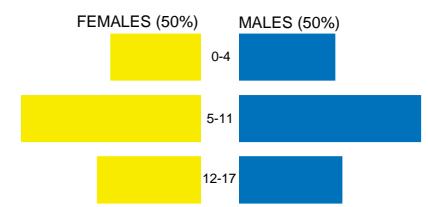

Gross Enrolment Rate (GER) – Primary + Secondary



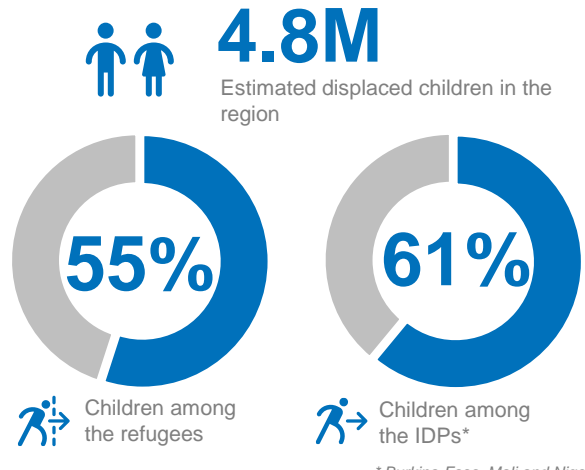

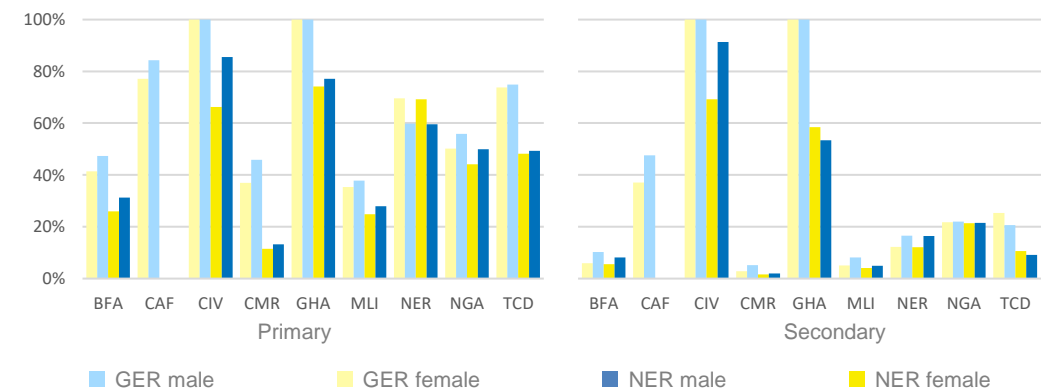

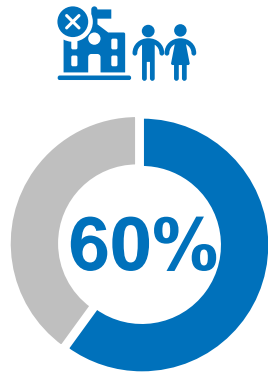

## Gross and Net Enrolment Rates (GER and NER) comparison by sex



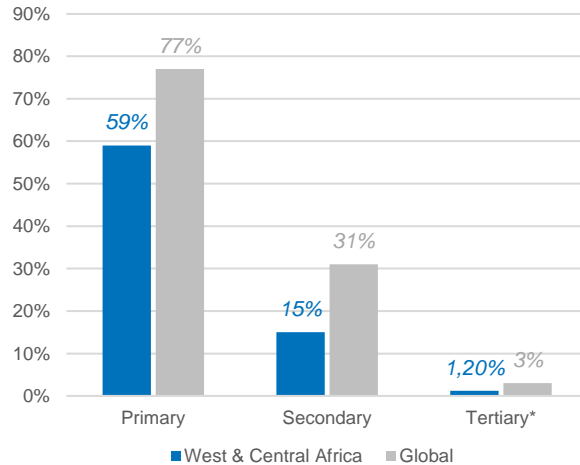

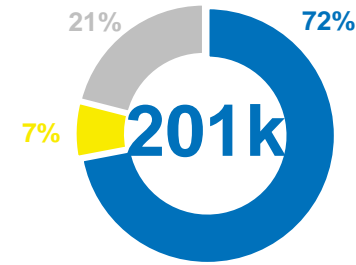
Estimated proportion of refugee children out of school

Comparison of refugee enrolment rates by school level for West & Central Africa vs globally

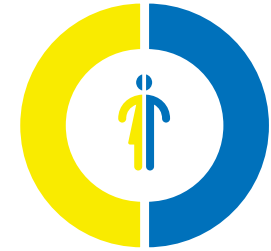

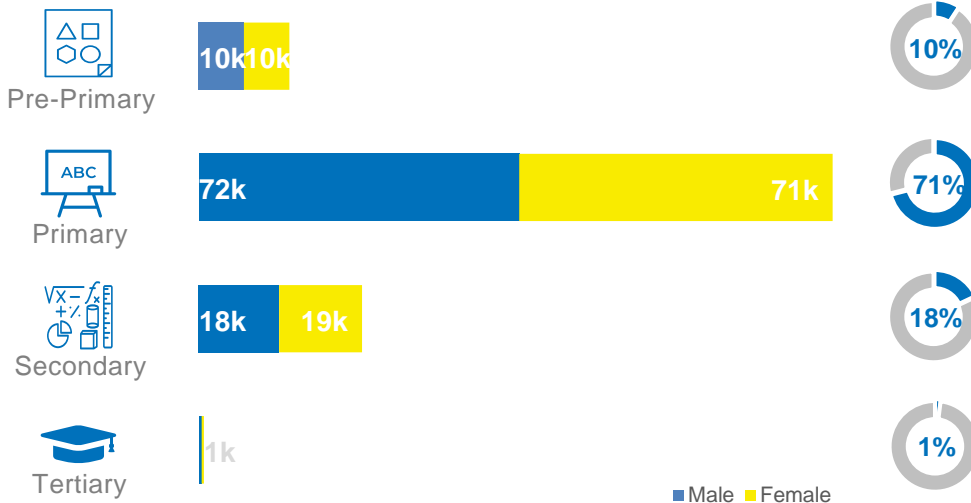

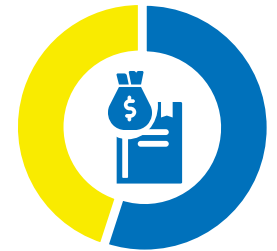

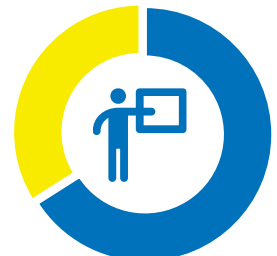
