

## **COVID-19 Updates**

#### **National COVID-19 Statistics**

As of 9 August 2021, the national cumulative COVID-19 statistics sood at:

Cumulative: **200,049 cases** Recovered: **192,479 (96%)** 

Those vaccinated under the 1stdose were

**302,475** (AZ, J&J, Sinopharm) The fully Vaccinated were: **191,592** 

Deaths: **3,484** Active cases: **4,086** 

• On 7 August 2021, the government received 100,000 doses of Sinopharm from the People's Republic of China and so encourage those willing to get a vaccine to do so at the earliest possible time to better protect and prevent any spikes and future waves.

## Refugee Settlement level

During the reporting period, no case of COVID-19 was recorded among the persons of concern (PoCs), hence figures remained the same **97**cases (M:44; F:53), recoveries: **95** with **0** Active and **02** death.

#### **POCs Vaccinations**

- In Meheba, the figure of vaccinated under 1<sup>st</sup> dose were **33**, while fully vaccinated PoCs were **32**.
- In Mantapala settlement, a total of 72 refugees received their first dose of COVID-19 vaccine, bringing the cumulative to 198 among the eligible individuals. In addition, six individuals received a second dose bringing the cumulative to 58

# **Risk Communication and Community Engagement**

- In Mebeba, sensitization was conducted and a total of 1, 524 (M:623;F: 901) individuals were reached with Covid-19 prevention messages
- The settlement has not recorded any positive active cases of Covid 19.

### Mantapala

MOH continued to conduct PCR (119) and RDT (27) COVID-19 tests for 146 individuals (130 refugees and 16 hosts). No positive case was found for RDTs while PCR results are pending.

#### Mayukwayukwa

A total of 1087 (M: 432; F:655) individuals were reached with sensitization messages on covid-19.

#### **Inter-Agency Coordination**

 On 5 August 2021, UNHCR held a joint virtual meeting with UNICEF, MOH, NFNC and COR to engage stakeholders on the upcoming Nutrition survey in the settlements
