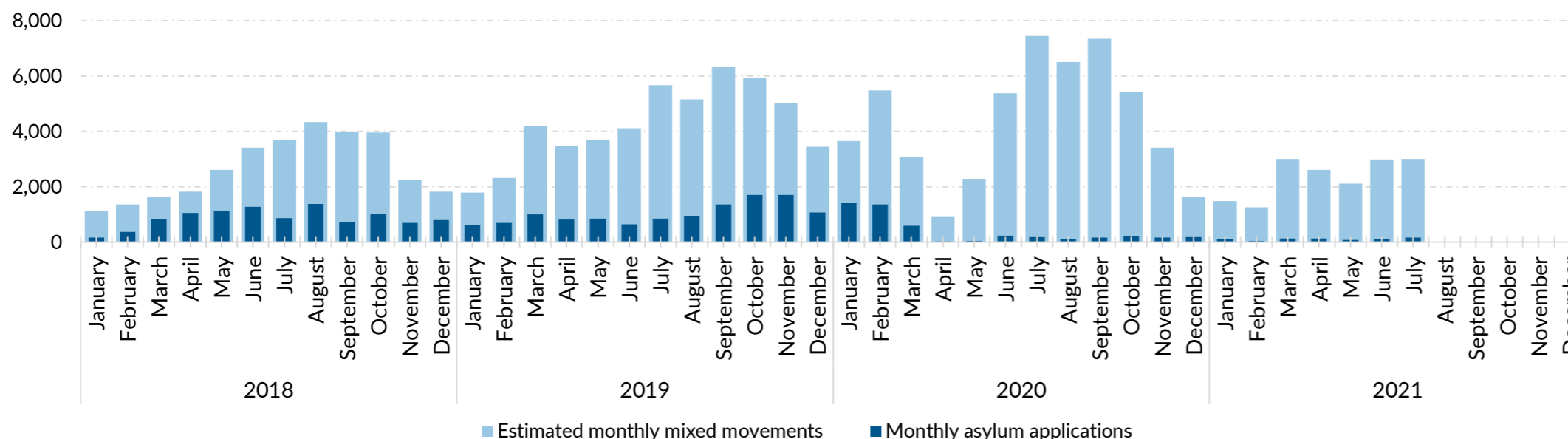
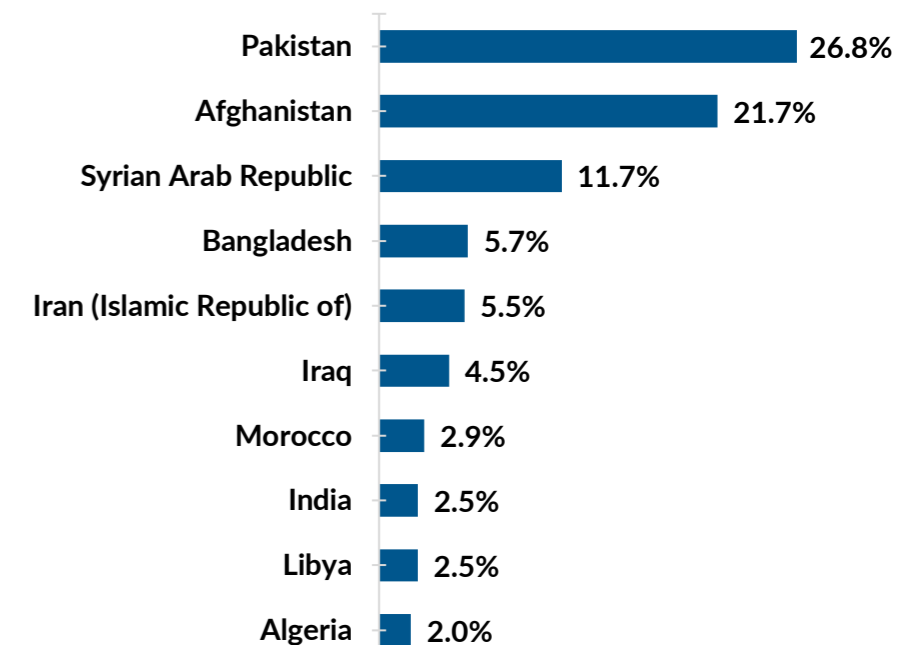

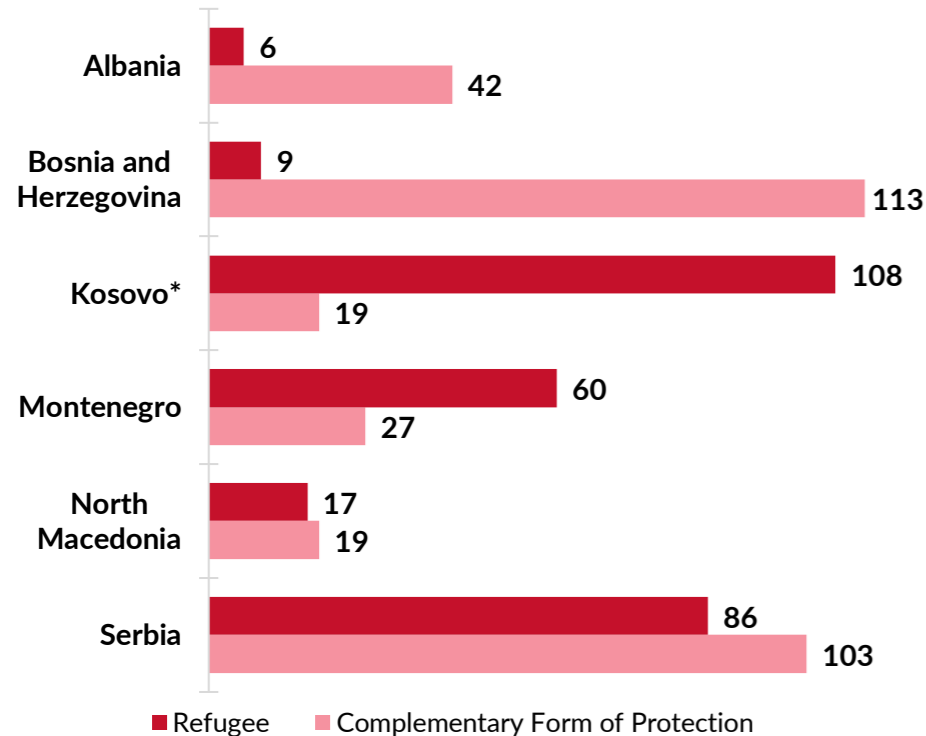
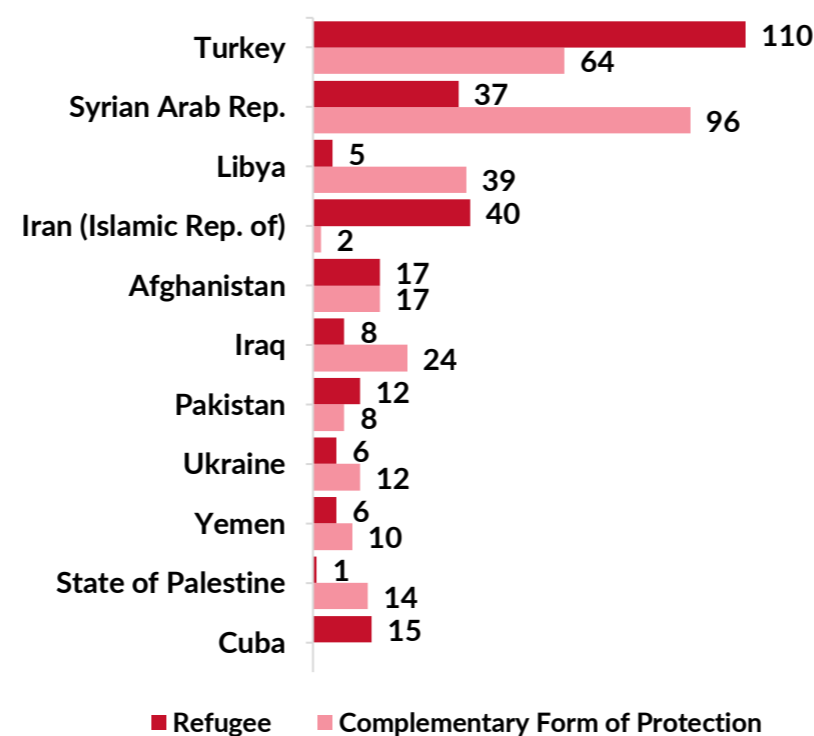
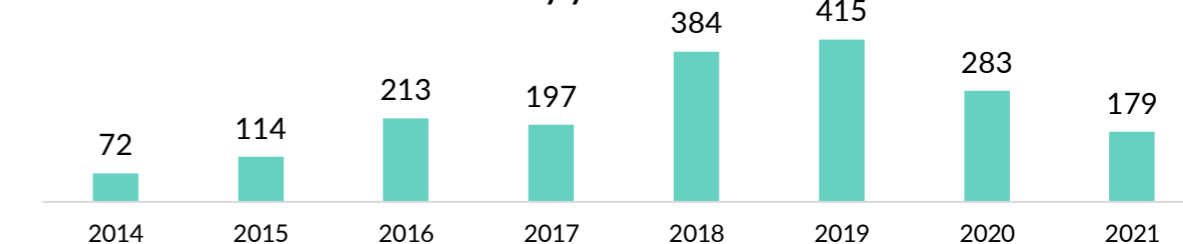
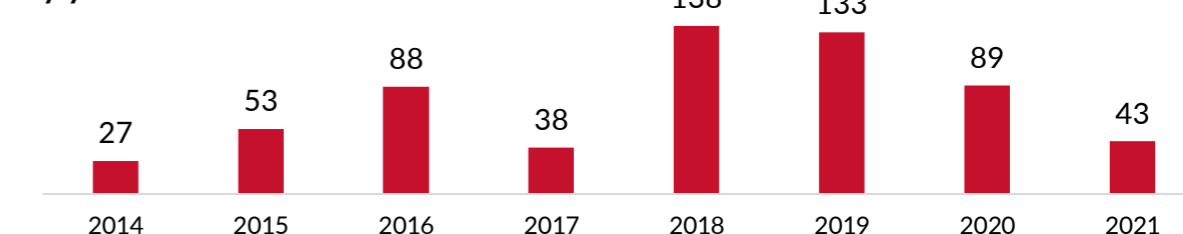
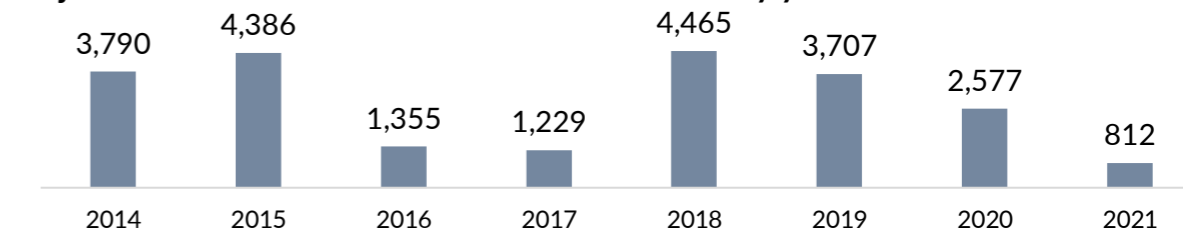

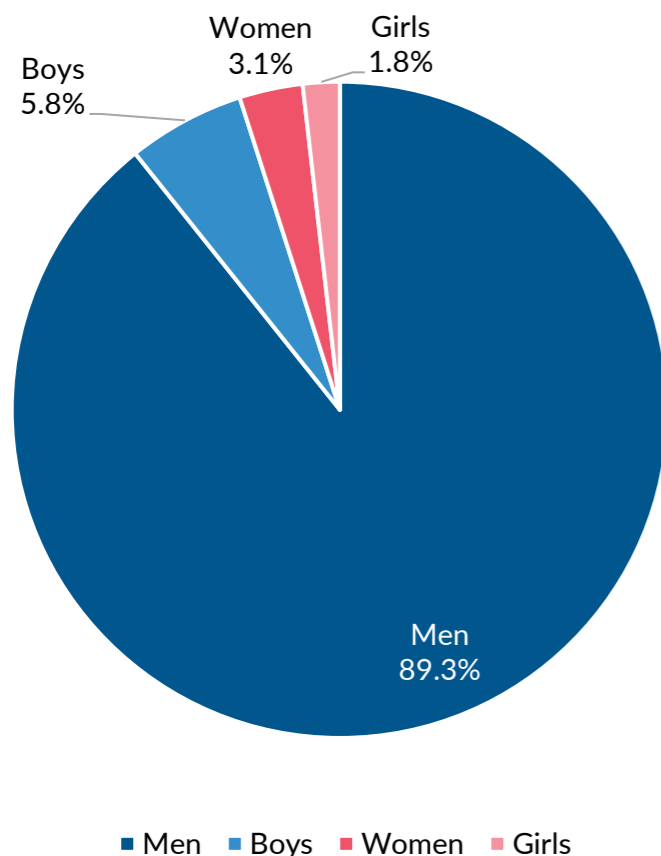

Adults in the mixed migration represent in % in 2021 in the Western Balkans **92.4%**

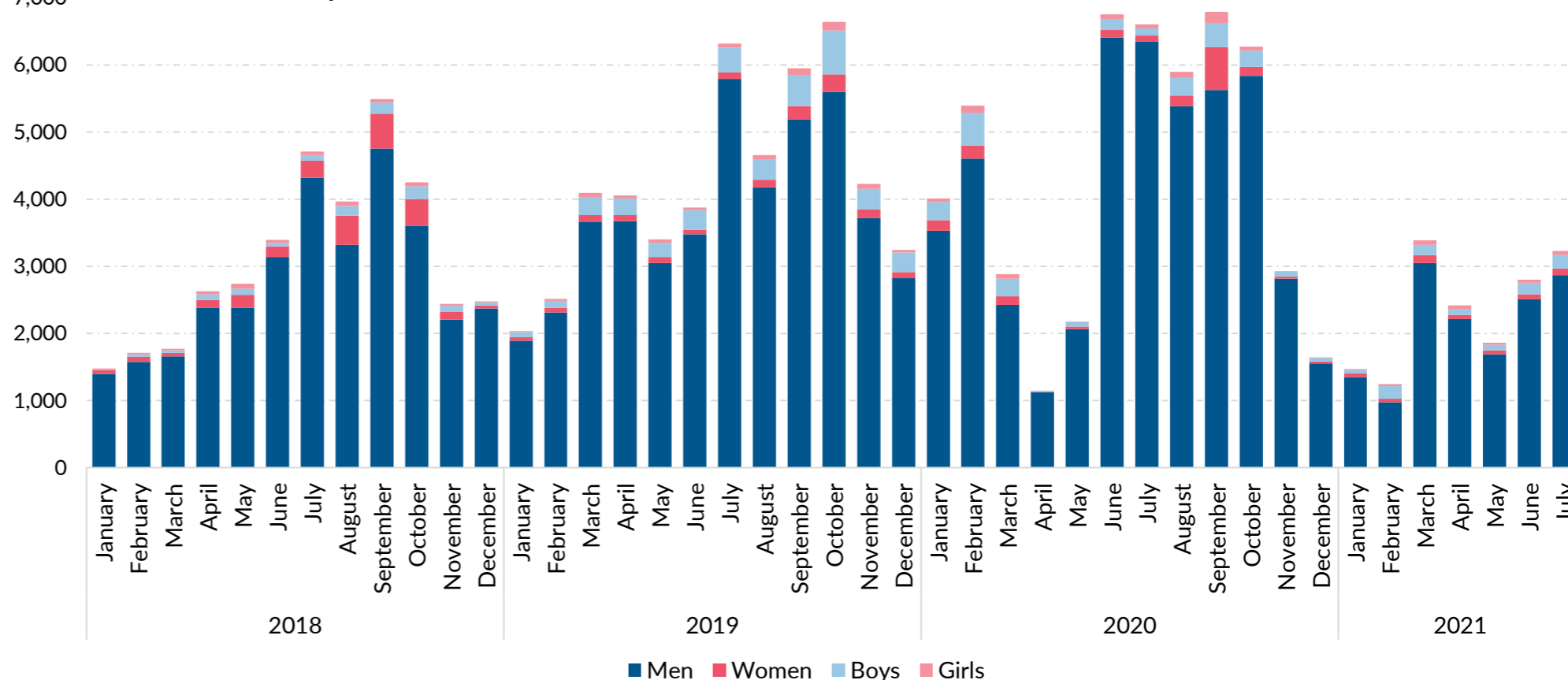
Children in the mixed migration represent in % in 2021 in the Western Balkans **7.6%**
