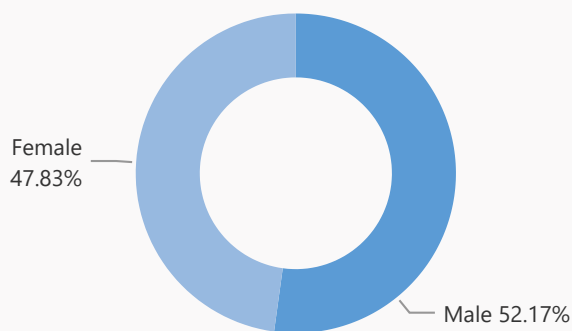
 **OVERVIEW**

Cash assistance is an important modality for UNHCR Libya operations enabling vulnerable persons of concern to UNHCR (PoCs) to cover some of their basic needs, which could include healthcare, medicines, rent and food.

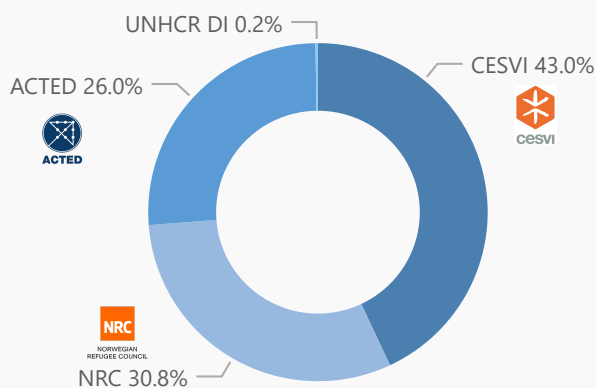

Organizations providing assistance by individuals reached

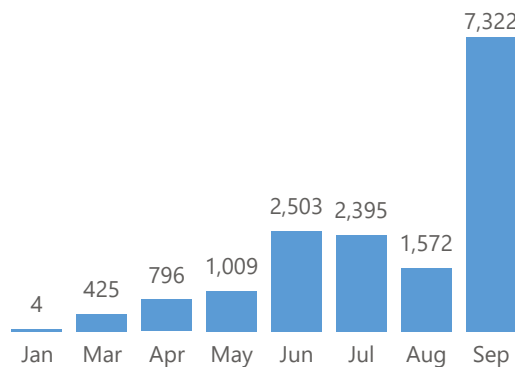

What do we do:

Cash provides dignity, flexibility and choice for the most vulnerable persons of concern to allow them to decide and address their own needs.

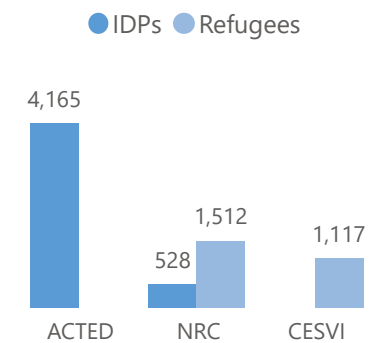
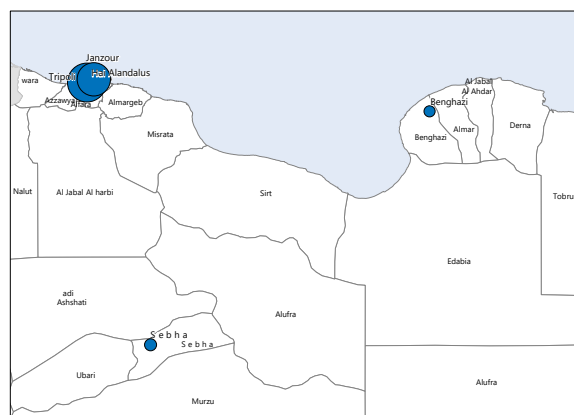
