


VERIFIED IDP SITES IN BAARDHEERE AS OF JUNE 2022




Map of verified IDP sites in Baardheere - June 2022

Assessment overview

IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Baardheere in May/June 2022 led by the Wadani Relief Organisation (WARO), Horn of Africa Relief and Development Agency (HARDA), NoFYL, Islamic Relief and SEDHURO. 23 IDP sites were identified hosting 13,970 households or 71,863 individuals. Compared to the last site verification conducted in November 2021, there was an decrease of 1 IDP sites and an increase of 11,249 Households or 60,979 individuals.

People living with disability

Using the washington group disability questions, statistics of people living with disabilities were

278 (49% Female) have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)

288 (52% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)

214 (51% Female) have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding

277 (49% Female) have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs

102 (66% Female) have difficulty with dressing and/or washing

68 (44% Female) have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

Eviction Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been

None of IDP sites have been classified

91% of sites have landowner authorized ownership type of land tenure

83% of sites have agreement in place

95% of those that have agreements have oral agreements

89% of those that have agreements have no agreed end dates

None of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of

4% of the sites has been classified as extreme (always floods) and high (floods High (flood frequently) Medium (floods infrequently)

Low (does not flood)
