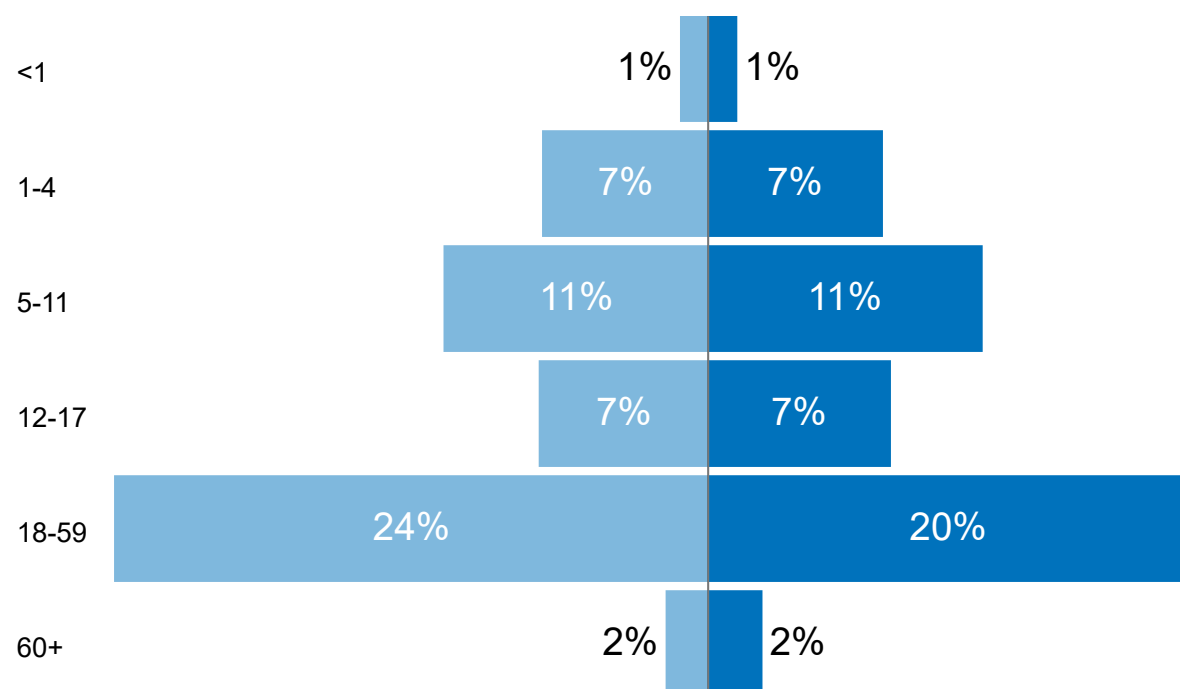

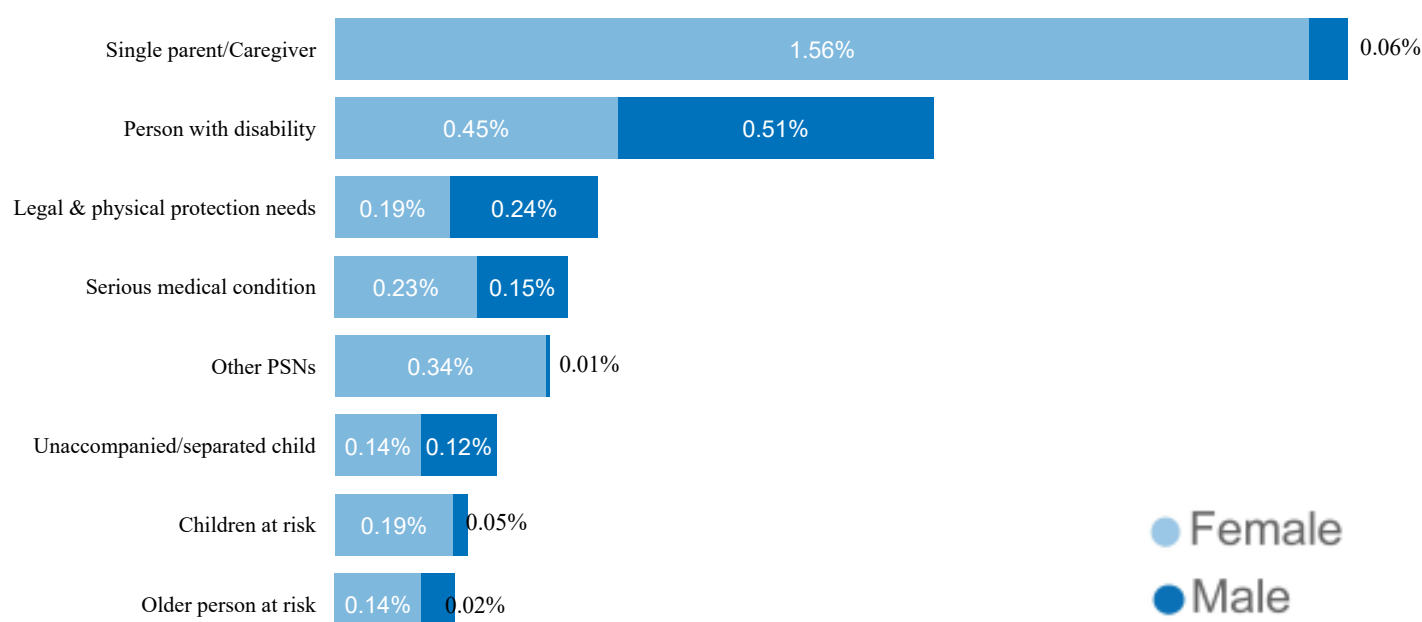

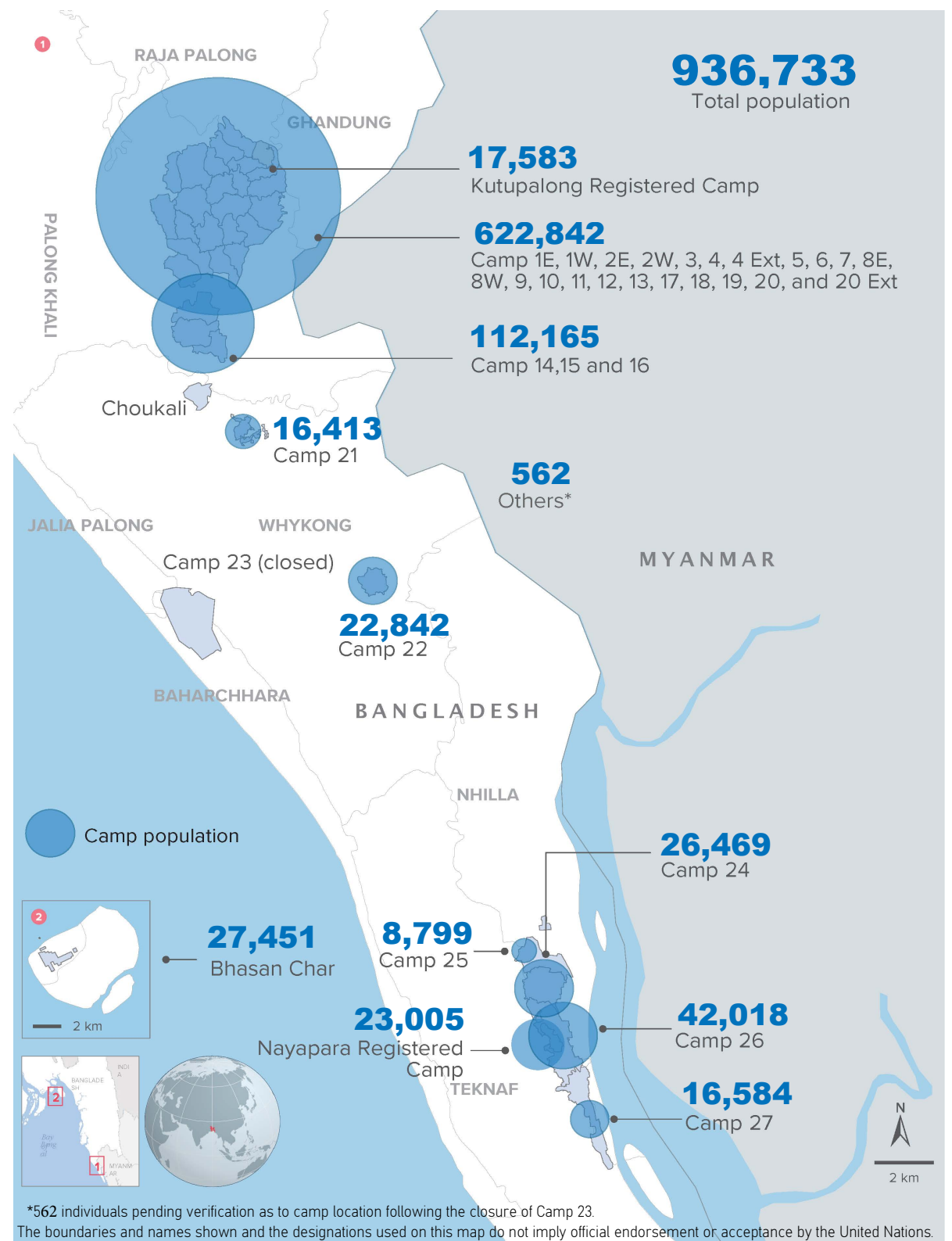
Specific needs ³

3.92% of total individuals have been identified with at least one specific need.



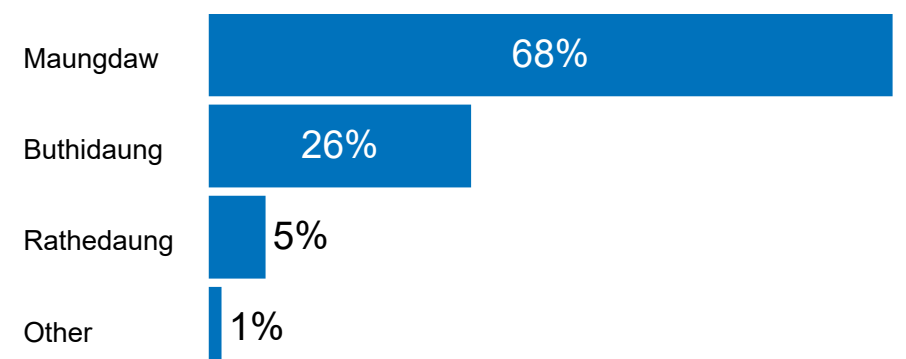

Rohingya Population by Location



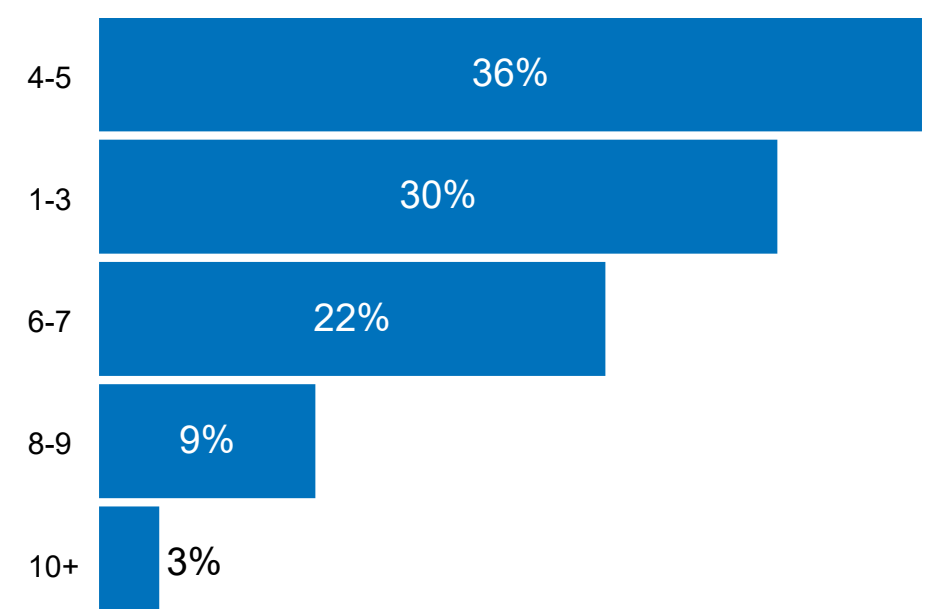
Place of origin
