

Somalia

1 - 31 August 2022

In August, 299,000 new internal displacements were monitored by the UNHCR-led Protection and Returns Monitoring Network (PRMN). Drivers include drought related (98,863), conflict and insecurity (197,281), flood (1,663) and others (837).

Hiraan (182,227) received the highest number of displaced persons followed by Bay (29,939), while Banadir (29,148), Lower Juba (15,88) and Gedo (13,770) regions also received relatively high numbers

33,670 Refugees & Asylum-Seekers


At the end of August 2022, there were 33,670 refugees and asylum-seekers registered in Somalia, mainly from Ethiopia (17,977 asylum seekers and 4,865 refugees), Yemen (9,392 refugees and asylum seekers) and Syria (1,050 refugees and 98 asylum seekes). The remaining 288 persons of concerns were from other countries

Refugee Returnees (2014 - 2022)


Since December 2014, 93,016 Somali refugees have voluntarily returned to Somalia with UNHCR assistance from different countries of asylum including Kenya, Yemen, Djibouti, Libya, Sudan and Eritrea. In addition, some 42,857 Somalis were monitored as arriving from Yemen since March 2015

Population of concern







