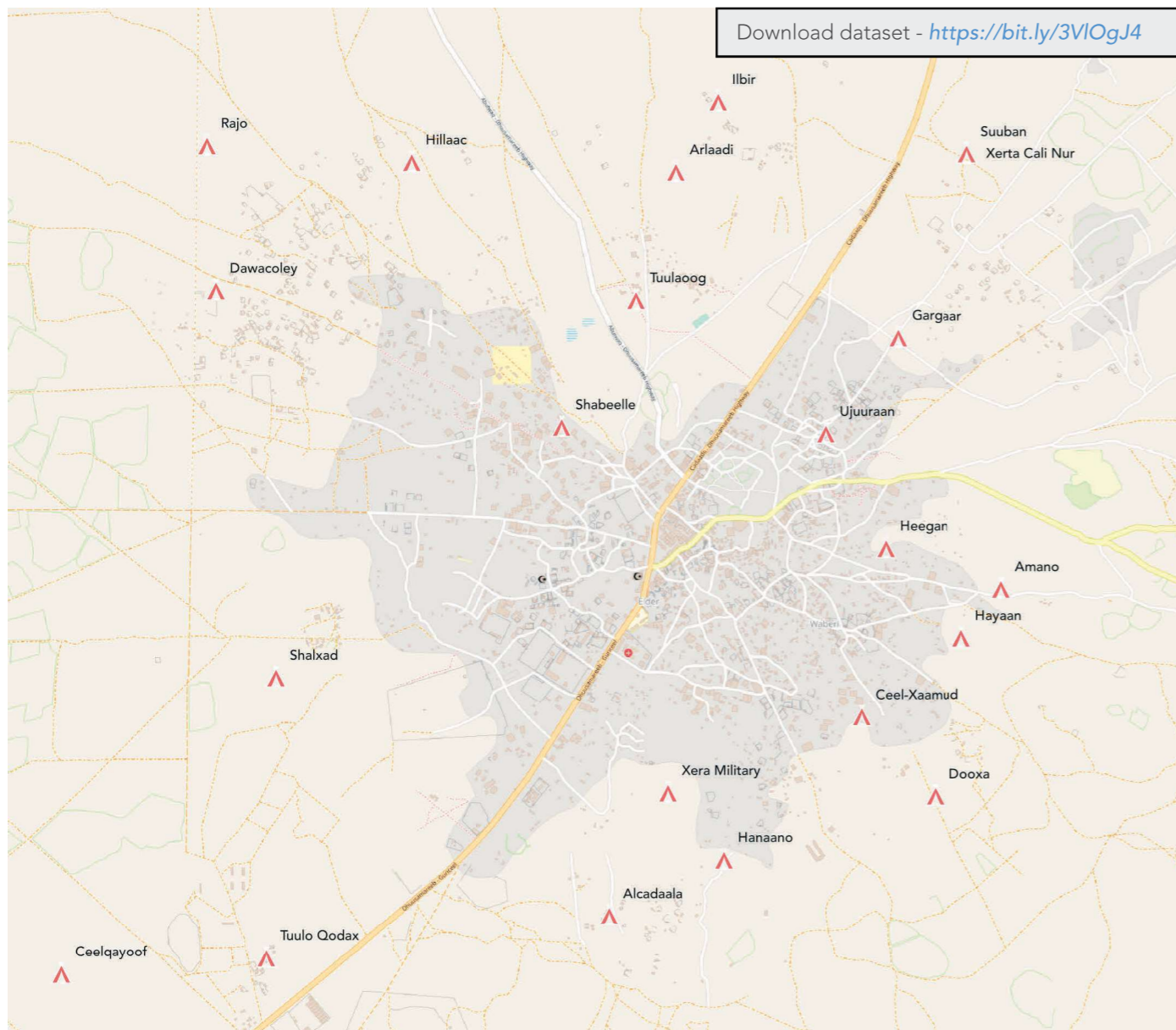

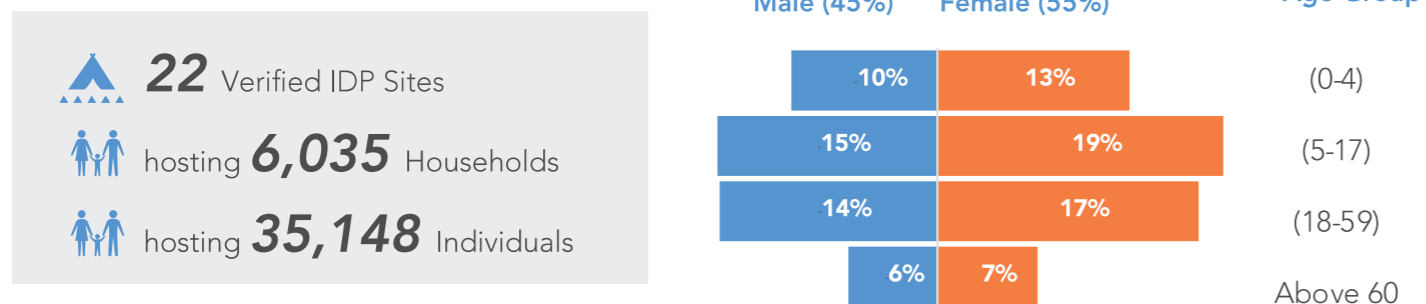


Map of verified IDP sites in Dhuusamarreeb - October 2022

Assessment overview

A joint IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Dhuusamarreeb in October 2022. The operation was led by the TOUS, Mercy Corps, GCRI, GECPD, DBG, APCO, DEH, NRC, IRC, OCHA and PAH. 22 IDP sites were identified hosting 6,035 households or 35,148 individuals. Compared to the last Site Verification conducted in March 2022, there was an increase of 1 IDP site but a decrease of 1,333 Households or 9,230 individuals.

People living with disability

Using the Washington Group Disability Questions, statistics of people living with disabilities were derived

2,078 (5.9%)
people living with disability

- 343 (48% Female)** have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)
- 323 (48% Female)** have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)
- 350 (59% Female)** have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding
- 496 (42% Female)** have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs
- 287 (52% Female)** have difficulty with dressing and/or washing
- 279 (34% Female)** have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

Eviction Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

13% of IDP sites have been classified as having extreme (9%) and high (5%) risk of eviction

- 86%** of sites have landowner authorized type of occupancy
- 64%** of sites have no agreement in place
- 75%** of those that have agreements have oral agreements
- 88%** of those that have agreements have no agreed end dates
- 9%** of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

4 IDP sites (19%) have been classified as extreme (always floods) and high (floods frequently)
