





192,000 1,598,000 874,000 (Jan - Oct 2022) in October (Jan - Oct 2021)

The UNHCR-led PRMN implemented in partnership with NRC reported 192,000 new internal displacements in the month of October 2022. Of these, 70,000 were triggered by conflict / insecurity while 108,000 were related to drought or lack of livelihood, 2,000 were displaced due to other reasons and 12,000 were as a result of floods.



BY REGION (Jan - Oct 2022)









BY DISTRICT (Jan - Oct 2022)







BY REGION (Jan - Oct 2022)










