Agenda Point 1 Operational updates by members	 <u>ACTED</u> – continues to support refugees, providing 16 RACs with hot meals daily and 2 RACs with vouchers in total 18 RACs. ACTED provides about 2,500 hot meals per day. <u>HelpAge</u> – continues to support refugees, providing 3 hot meals daily in 28 accredited RACs (24 RACs - catering and 4 RACs - vouchers). At the moment, HelpAge provides hot meals for about 1,700 refugees. <u>Peace Winds Japan</u> – continues to provide food assistance to the NCUM Center (National Congress of Ukrainian people in Moldova). PWJ provides about 200 hot meals per week. For Patria Lukoil Centre, PWJ provides about 2,000 package per week. <u>AAH</u> - provides food assistance - hot meals outside of the RACs and currently continue their assistance in Palanca and the region of Stefan Voda. They have started to provide snacks at the bus station in Otachi. 	To come up with new updates at the next meeting.
