1. Review of minutes of last meeting

2. Presentation on Site Monitoring and On-Site Needs Assessment

UNHCR and IOM presented the interagency exercise conducted in partnership with REACH. This exercise is conformed by two assessments to obtained information on the situation of the mapped sites, and a snapshot of the needs of the refugees hosted on those sites. Results were presented to the IMWG members. The comprehensive report can be downloaded from the ODP – LINK.

Action points:

UNHCR, IOM and REACH will continue informing IMWG members on the next stages of this exercise.

3. Update on assessments

REACH made an update on the ongoing assessments in collaboration with UNHCR: Site monitoring information will be updated on a factsheet that will be shared in the coming days, and the Area Based Assessment data collection is about to finish. This assessment is focused on access to services and social cohesion in Bratislava, Kosice, Nitra and Zilina. Results will be shared by January and presented in the IMWG.

WHO introduced the Health needs assessment conducted in Kosice; results will be shared/presented on the next IMWG. Additionally, IFRC will provide more information on their ongoing and planned assessment on the next IMWG

4. RRP Update - Indicators 2023

As part of the RRP 2023 process, the framework with the list of activities and indicators will be adapted for next year monitoring and reporting. The new framework takes into consideration the new regional indicators, and the type of activities proposed by partners for next year. The first draft of country indicators was already shared with 2023 RRP partners and IMWG members, and feedback provided. A second version has been shared for final feedback to IMWG members, including proposed targets to regional indicators. Additionally, an indicator & reporting guide will be drafted and shared with members in January.
