
CCCM Cluster VERIFIED IDP SITES IN BURTINLE AS OF DECEMBER 2022



Assessment overview

IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Burtinle in December 2022 by PSA.

4 IDP sites were identified hosting 590 households or 2,000 individuals. Compared to the previous site verification excercise in March 2022, there was no change of the number IDP Sites, a decrease of 918 households and 3,140 individuals.

People living with disability

Using the washington group disability questions, statistics of people living with disabilities were derived

1 46 (48% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)

1 26 (54% Female) have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs

Eviction Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

100% of IDP sites have been classified as having extreme risk of evictic

100% of sites have a Communal/Permanent ownership type of land tenure

100% of sites have agreement in place

100% of those that have agreements have written agreements

0% of those that have agreements have no agreed end dates

100% of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months
