


VERIFIED IDP SITES IN CADAADO AS OF DECEMBER 2022

Assessment overview

IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Cadaado in December 2022 by DEH, GCRI, GECPD, Local Authority, NoFYL, PAH, SCI, SPL, SSWC, TUOS and UNHCR.

9 IDP sites were identified hosting 7,902 households or 47,424 individuals. Compared to the previous site verification excercise in April 2022, there was an increase of 2 IDP Sites, of 2,673 households and 16,057 individuals.

People living with disability

Using the washington group disability questions, statistics of people living with disabilities were derived

1,311 (1.95%)

314 (52% Female) have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)

 † 189 (46% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)

130 (52% Female) have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding

129 (42% Female) have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs

106 (50% Female) have difficulty with dressing and/or washing

143 (48% Female) have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

Eviction Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

15% of IDP sites have been classified as having extreme (7.69%) and high (7.69%) risk of eviction

69% of sites have a Communal/Permanent ownership type of land tenure

38% of sites have agreement in place

75% of those that have agreements have written agreements

63% of those that have agreements have no agreed end dates

8% of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

15% of the sites has been classified as high (floods frequently) risk of flooding

High (Floods frequently)	Medium (Floods infrequently)	Low (Never Floods)
