## Unregistered Population

In 2022 there was a continuous influx of persons from Cameroon in Adamawa, Cross River, Benue, Taraba, Akwa Ibom, Anambra and Enugu States. An estimated 16,077 persons are yet to be registered, with 64\% of the unregistered population located in Madagali, Mubi North, Mubi South and Michika Local Government Areas in Adamawa State.
