<b>Updated figures and announcements (UNHCR)</b>	<p><b>Update figures:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- European Asylum Agency has taken over from General Inspector for Immigration (GII) the issuance of Temporary Protection (TP)</li> <li>- Romania has significant increase in number of asylum applications.</li> <li>- Stefan (IM) to add the location of TP issuance in the presentation for next ISWG meeting.</li> <li>- Some people will move to other areas due to the start of academic year. Dormitories should be evacuated for students.</li> <li>- Partners should monitor the school capacity absorption in order to advise people where to move.</li> </ul> <p><b>2022 Recalibration:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Narrative was shared with regional office; they are compiling all narratives to produce a regional narrative which is supposed to be shared with us on 26 September.</li> <li>- Sector Leads to review the regional narrative in a short time after its circulation by Inter-Agency (IA).</li> <li>- All appealing partners (23) in RRP provided their revised budget which is less than the original budget. For example Mercy Corps reduced its budget by USD 5M; additional funding was allocated to Livelihood WG.</li> <li>- Progress update (RRP indicators):</li> <li>- Basic Needs and Livelihood WGs to add food and livelihood indicators respectively.</li> <li>- CASH and Health WGs to revise some indicators which are very high comparing to other countries next week.</li> </ul> <p>Follow up Points:</p>

<b>Sectoral updates (targeted, action-oriented, activities / gaps)</b>	<p><b><u>Internews presentation on the result of its research:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Presentation and results are attached. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Russian translation should be improved especially for information products/documents/signs.</li> <li>- IA, IM and CwC to look into the centralization of information for refugees but also into the “localization” of the information to make it geographically relevant</li> <li>- Additional attention needed to make messaging/information age appropriate and accessible to all.</li> <li>- IA and AAP to make sure that voice of refugees is included in 2023 RRP planning (complaint and feedback mechanism).</li> <li>- Internews will share the full research’s report and cooperate with CwC to improve the communication with community.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b><u>Adolescents and Youth Task Force:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Already 23 organization showed interest to be part of the TF.</li> <li>• First meeting will take place next week.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Information Management Working Group:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• RefData Meet Up event will take place on 22 September with the aim of bringing local authorities, government and IMWG closer. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The WG will share the MSNA tool next week with the aim of data collection on second week of October and providing the first analytical result on the first week of November.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• The Romanian Government has recently developed a separate website for sharing information with the Ukrainian refugees in Romanian and Ukrainian (<a href="https://protectieucraina.gov.ro">https://protectieucraina.gov.ro</a>).</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Health Working Group:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Workplan was shared. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A workshop will take place to prepare the WG’s ToR. Those who are interested to attend should inform Niki in WHO.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b><u>Basic Needs Working Group:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Report of the last working session on winterization will be shared by the end of today and finalized by next week after incorporation all comments.</li> <li>- Multi mission of UNHCR, UNICEF and IOM went to Bulgaria to assess needs. More information will be shared.
