UNHCR's mission is to save lives, alleviate suffering and maintain human dignity during crises.

IMPARTIALITY

UNHCR's work is devoted to supporting civilians in need. Priority given to civilians in most distress, regardless of ethnicity or religion. We do not assist armed combatants.

INDEPENDENCE

UNHCR's work is completely free of political and external influence.

NEUTRALITY

UNHCR does not engage in hostilities or armed conflict.

- We are independent, non-political and do not engage in armed conflict.
- We have been present in Myanmar since 1993 and have over 200 staff at 11 locations.
- We care for the needs of over 2 million civilians in need across Myanmar.
- We follow all rules and regulations, and travel with relevant approvals.
