


Timeline of key events



6 Feb • Refugees begin crossing the border due to fighting in Laas Caanood and surrounding areas.

20 Feb • Six trucks carrying critical relief items (CRIs,) for about 9,000 vulnerable families, received in Bokh.

1-4 Mar RRS Director General & UNHCR Representative undertake a mission to Doolo zone with regional and local authorities.
