Introduction	Introduction of AAP Task Force meeting by Irene Basiul with the announcement on launching the TP campaign.	
Rumor tracking Elena Cernicova, Moldova For Peace	Rumor tracking presentation. The rumors that have been collected in its majority came from Viber and Telegram. The main rumors are in regards to: Cash-assistance Temporary Protection Vignette for the cars with Ukrainian numbers Humanitarian assistance Other points of discussion: Cash assistance problems (sms, notifications, unreceived support) Caritas closed the cash-assistance program in UTA Gagauzia Lack of relevant information on cash-assistance General questions The main concern among refugees is the new legal status, and the lack of humanitarian assistance in certain regions.	
	The tension between the Moldovan and refugee community increased, mainly because of the disparity in cash assistance.	
Temporary Protection Status	The information campaign has been launched by the Ministry of Internal Affairs, who will be the official source of information regarding TP. The Bureau of Migration and Asylum (BMA), now called Inspectorate General for Migration, is the authority responsible of TP. A general presentation on TP was shared, covering: Who is eligible for TP Rights and obligations, including social assistance, health (the list of available services for refugees will be presented by the Ministry of Health) 45 days available for being outside of the country. Refugees will have to keep track of the days the spend outside of the country, including day of departure and the day of arrival.	





	 How to apply: 2 steps procedure (pre-registration online and in at least 10 days documentation for receiving the TPS) Information campaign, TPS materials will be available in Ukrainian, Russian, Romanian, English and Romani (with the support of Roma Task Force) At the moment there are no changes in cash-assistance program by UNHCR 	
	Avoid duplication, coordinate communication offices.	
Other topics	There is a need for psychosocial assistance for humanitarian workers (free of charge) as there are high levels of burnout and no support in the health system. IOM offered assistance, as they have provided training for humanitarian workers in the past.
